Tadlock Roofing Donates \$2,000 to Blanche Daughtrey Elementary School

Bradenton, FL - October 14, 2021 - Nearly one in four children in Manatee County is unsure about the source and quality of his or her next meal according to the Herald Tribune. Blanche Daughtrey Elementary School is no stranger to the child hunger epidemic and poverty being faced by its student body, as the school enrolls 65% economically disadvantaged students. Local roofing contractor, Tadlock Roofing, was made aware of the school's needs and is stepping up to the occasion by donating \$2,000 to the school on Thursday, October 14 at 11am.
